Are the number of satellites for both constellations mandatory? Or can we provide the minimum?	The constellation required for daily optical of at least 100 satellites is necessary to provide daily captures anywhere in the country. No alternative number was suggested; thus, we will retain the at least 100 satellites.
Is a foreign bidder allowed to participate in the above tenders?	Please be informed that Par. 2, Item 3, Section I. Invitation to Bid, provides that the bidding is open to all interested bidders, whether foreign or local.
Shall a bid price be quoted in Philippine Pesos only?	Section II. Instructions to Bidders, Clause 13.1. states that, <i>“For Goods that the Bidder will supply from outside the Philippines, the bid prices may be quoted in the local currency or tradeable currency accepted by the BSP at the discretion of the Bidder. However, for purposes of bid evaluation, Bids denominated in foreign currencies, shall be converted to Philippine currency based on the</i>

	<p><i>exchange rate as published in the BSP reference rate bulletin on the day of the bid opening.”</i></p> <p>Please note, however, that Clause 13.2. provides that payment will be made in Philippine currency only.</p>
