**RECOMMENDING AWARD OF CONTRACT VIA NEGOTIATED PROCUREMENT –
TWO FAILED BIDDINGS FOR THE REPLACEMENT OF DOORS AT DOST-ASTI BUILDING
(INCLUDING REMOVAL AND REFRAMING)**

WHEREAS, the Republic Act (RA) No. 9184, otherwise known as the “Government Procurement Reform Act”, provides that all procurement of the national government, its departments, bureaus, offices, and agencies, including state universities and colleges, government-owned and/or controlled corporations, government financial institutions and local government units, shall, in all cases be conducted in accordance therewith and its 2016 revised Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR);

WHEREAS, the **Fiscal Year 2024 Annual Procurement Plan No. 7** of the Department of Science and Technology (DOST) - Advanced Science and Technology Institute (ASTI) includes “**Replacement of Doors at DOST-ASTI Building (Including Removal and Reframing)**”, to be procured through public bidding, with a total Approved Budget for the Contract amounting **One Million Four Hundred Fifty-Five Thousand Seven Hundred Sixty Pesos Only (₱1,455,760.00)**, inclusive of all government taxes, other fees and charges;

WHEREAS, the DOST-ASTI Bids and Awards Committee (BAC) received **Purchase Request No. GAA-24-06-19356** dated **05 June 2024**, together with a market study, for the procurement of the aforesaid item;

WHEREAS, the DOST-ASTI BAC declared two (2) failed public biddings for the procurement project. The first failure of bidding was declared through **BAC Resolution No. 24-07-141** dated **19 July 2024**, and second failure of bidding was declared through **BAC Resolution No. 24-08-161** dated **22 August 2024**;

WHEREAS, due to two (2) failed biddings, the DOST-ASTI BAC resorted to Negotiated Procurement after Two Failed Biddings as provided for in Section 53.1 of RA No. 9184 and its 2016 revised IRR;

WHEREAS, on **17 September 2024**, the Invitation for Negotiation was published on the websites of the PhilGEPS and DOST-ASTI, as well as in the latter’s conspicuous place reserved for the purpose, consistent with Section 21, Rule VII of the 2016 revised IRR of RA No. 9184;

WHEREAS, the deadline for submission of Best and Final Bid Offer/s for the procurement project is on **02 October 2024, 9:00 AM**;

WHEREAS, Letters of Invitation were sent to three (3) witnesses and/or observers, namely:

WHEREAS, on **20 September 2024, 09:00 AM**, a **Negotiation Conference** for said procurement was conducted by DOST-ASTI BAC through videoconferencing, specifically via MS Teams, which was opened to prospective bidders;

WHEREAS, only one (1) prospective bidder submitted the eligibility, technical, and financial requirements prior to the deadline of submission on **02 October 2024, 09:00 AM**, particularly **Asyana Construction, Consultancy and Trading**;

WHEREAS, the DOST-ASTI BAC opened the offers/quotations of the prospective bidders in public and in the presence of the bidders' representatives, via blended meeting arrangement, to determine the bidders' compliance with the eligibility, technical, and financial requirements specified in the Invitation;

WHEREAS, the DOST-ASTI BAC examined the submitted documents of the prospective bidders versus a checklist to ascertain if the required documents were all submitted, using a non-discretionary "pass or fail" criterion;

WHEREAS, it was determined by the DOST-ASTI BAC that **Asyana Construction, Consultancy and Trading** submitted the required legal, technical, and financial documents/requirements. Thus, the DOST-ASTI BAC rated the legal, technical, and financial documents/requirements of **Asyana Construction, Consultancy and Trading** bid as "**passed**";

WHEREAS, the DOST-ASTI BAC proceeded to open the financial component/documents submitted by **Asyana Construction, Consultancy and Trading**, and its price quotation amounted to **One Million Four Hundred Two Thousand Seventy-Three Pesos and 6/100 Only (₱1,402,073.06)**, inclusive of all government taxes, other fees, and charges;

WHEREAS, after verification of all statements made and documents submitted by **Asyana Construction, Consultancy and Trading**, the end-user unit and DOST-ASTI BAC determined that the submission of said prospective bidder passed all the criteria and requirements of the Procuring Entity for the procurement project at hand;

NOW, THEREFORE, FOR AND IN CONSIDERATION OF THE FOREGOING, we, the members of the DOST-ASTI BAC hereby resolves to:

1. To declare the quotation of **Asyana Construction, Consultancy and Trading** for the procurement project titled, "**Replacement of Doors at DOST-ASTI Building (Including Removal and Reframing)**", with a total price quotation of **One Million Four Hundred Two Thousand Seventy-Three Pesos and 6/100 Only (₱1,402,073.06)**, as the **Single Calculated Responsive Quotation**; *and*
2. To award the contract to **Asyana Construction, Consultancy and Trading** in the aforesaid amount through Negotiated Procurement after Two Failed Biddings.
